Selection Criteria for Induction into the AFLNT Hall of Fame.

1. The Committee shall consider a candidate's outstanding services and overall contribution to the game of Australian Football in determining a candidate's eligibility for induction in the Hall of Fame.
2. Without limiting clause 1 the Committee may consider a candidate's individual record, ability, integrity, sportsmanship and character.
3. The number of football games played, coached or umpired or the years of service provided shall only be a consideration and shall not be conclusive in assessing a candidate's eligibility.
4. A player, coach, umpire, administrator, media representative or any team involved at any level of Australian Football may be eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame.
5. Candidates shall be adjudged on the basis of their overall contribution to Australian Football as opposed to one specific aspect.
6. The Committee shall consider candidates from all parts of the Northern Territory and the Affiliated Leagues of AFL Northern Territory.
7. A player may only be eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame if that player has retired from playing Australian Football for a minimum period of three years.
8. Coaches, umpires, administrators and media representatives may only be eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame upon retirement.
9. Representative teams may be eligible for selection in the Hall of Fame
10. A member of the Committee may be a candidate but shall not vote for his or her induction into the Hall of Fame.
11. There shall be no special order of precedence given to Hall of Fame inductees.
