

MLLLC Employment Pathways Program



Utilising football as a pathway to employment, the MLLLC Employment Pathways Leadership Program, complements the Australian curriculum and is designed to foster potential opportunities with the AFL and local employers. Working life is explored and experienced through a one-week residential stay at the MLLLC.

Students engage in;

- Lessons based on job readiness, wellbeing and OHS in the workplace
- Resume and cover letter writing
- Visits to a range of local employment and training centres, such as Charles Darwin University, School of Health, NORFORCE, Aboriginal Broadcasting Australia or others as requested by schools
- Mini work experience at AFLNT hosted by our reception, café, cleaning, game development and media teams
- NT Thunder mentoring sessions
- Fitness training, sports sessions and use of our state of the art, gym pool and oval facilities.

The program is targeted for students aged between **14-17 years**.

The program costs **\$850 per student** - excluding travel to and from the Centre.



This price includes; food, accommodation, coordination and facilitation of activities, use of MLLLC facilities, education materials and resources, an MLLLC T-shirt, photos, media coverage via the MLLLC Facebook page, program and logistics support for schools plus the use of our 22-seat bus.

The recommended group size is between 10-16 students. A minimum of one teacher and community member are required for supervision.
